Plaintiffs ALEX LANDEROS and LUIS LANDEROS (hereinafter "Plaintiffs") by and through their counsel of record, Joaquin Avila, Esq., of Joaquin G. Avila Law Office and Defendants COMPTON COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT ("District") and GENETHIA HUDLEY-HAYES, SPECIAL TRUSTEE TO THE COMPTON COMMUNITY COLLEGE

1 DISTRICT ("Special Trustee"), by and through their counsel of record, Warren S. Kinsler, Esq.,
2 of Atkinson, Andelson, Loya, Ruid & Romo, do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

3 **STIPULATION**

4 1. Plaintiffs alleged that the District was in violation of the California Voting Rights
5 Act of 2001 (California Elections Code sections 14025, *et seq.* [the "CVRA"]) and the California
6 Constitution (Cal. Const., Art. 21, sec. 2(d)) because the District's method of election resulted in
7 vote dilution for Latino residents and denied them effective political participation in governing
8 board member elections and the District's method of election prevents Latino residents from
9 electing candidates of their choice or influencing the outcome of the District's elections.

10 2. In response to the filing of this action, Plaintiffs and Defendants entered into a
11 stipulated injunction enjoining the November 2011 governing board member election, which was
12 approved and signed by the Court on July 7, 2011.

13 3. Plaintiffs and District have further entered into a settlement agreement which
14 provided for, among other things, the transition of the District's election method to a true district-
15 based method consisting of one trustee area per governing board member seat ("Agreement").

16 4. The parties have taken all actions required of them by the terms of the Agreement
17 and now desire that this matter be dismissed, with prejudice.


18 **THEREFORE IT IS STIPULATED AS FOLLOWS:**
